All dealers will be notified the same day. He said that this year, Porsche has built more GT cars than in the past. He received more GTS models than S cars, especially in the 911 line.

The dealership renovation and expansion continues. Demolition has been completed and construction is progressing well. Although completion was estimated to be in January, he would be happy to see completion sometime in the first quarter of 2024 due to City inspections and approvals.

Their Oktoberfest event for the launch of the new Cayenne was a success with an estimated 150 in attendance from both SBR and the Central Coast Region, which the dealership also sponsors. Rene provided six tickets to the Porsche Experience Center, which were given out by Rod via email.
